Madeira Beach Issues Traffic Reminders for Gulf. Boulevard

MADEIRA BEACH, FL – As Madeira Beach continues through the height of “snowbird season”, driving the 2-miles from one end of the community to the other can sometimes take a bit more time and patience. City officials, working closely with contractors, are reminding both residents and visitors to give themselves some extra time before heading out onto Gulf Blvd. in the coming weeks.

“We live on one square mile of island and in one of the most popular destinations on the gulf coast, so yes, there will always be traffic issues,” said Public Information Officer Curt Preisser. “That is why we work so closely with contractors, requiring them to employ traffic mitigation strategies including hiring traffic control staff, lane detours and alternate routes to help keep things moving smoothly.”



Drivers should be aware of slowdowns in 13000, 14000 and 21000 blocks of Gulf Blvd., (Snug Harbor Inn, Madeira Bay Resort and Barefoot Beach Resort) are expected to cause some traffic delays in the coming weeks. While a full closure of Gulf Blvd. is not expected, drivers should be aware of single lane detours, and short delays due to large construction vehicles entering and exiting job sites.
