Pinellas County to Perform Maintenance on Drinking Water System

Beginning Monday, April 22nd, Pinellas County will start a routine system maintenance program designed to optimize water quality. The process, which includes water services in Madeira Beach, involves temporarily changing the water treatment method from using chloramine to using chlorine disinfection. This process will be in effect from April 22 to May 11, 2019.



The water is perfectly safe to drink during this period, though you may notice a slight difference in the taste or odor of the water. Users of kidney dialysis machines and owners of aquatic life should not be impacted but should contact their respective service providers for more information.
