Improvement Projects Will Temporarily Impact Traffic

MADEIRA BEACH, FL – Contractors working on improving roadways, utilities, and new buildings will be busy over the next couple of weeks.

Contractors developing Hotel A of the Town Center project at the intersection of 150th Ave. and Madeira Way have informed the city they will be ready to perform the last major pouring of concrete for the building and parking garage next week. **Because the process will involve the temporary closing of the northbound entrance to Madeira Way, the city has instructed the developer to inform the city 24 hours in advance. Access to Madeira Way will remain open from Gulf Blvd.**



On Tuesday, April 16th, Ajax Paving crews will move to the next phase of the Gulf Blvd. resurfacing project. The milling phase of the project will be done in sections, and one lane at a time, to minimize traffic congestion on Gulf Blvd. Crews will begin work on the northbound right lane of Gulf Blvd., at 131st Ave., and proceed north to 150th Ave. (Tom Stuart Causeway). When that lane is complete, Ajax Paving will move to the southbound right lane and continue south and then repeat the process for the inside lanes. The entire process is expected to take about one week.

During the week of April 23rd Pinellas County Utilities will be working in the area of 399 150th Ave. to lower a manhole cover and repair curbing near the entrance to Madeira Cove Condominiums. The repair process will require the closure of right turn entrance lane into the condominium property.

On Tuesday, April 30th, contractors for Duke Energy will temporarily close a small section of one lane on Gulf Blvd. near the intersection of 140th Ave. to allow work crews to drill shafts to support new traffic signals and safety lights for the pedestrian crossing. Gulf Blvd. will remain open during this process as the temporary closures will be staggered allowing traffic to move to the adjoining lane.
