## **Public Works/Marina Director Resigns**

MADEIRA BEACH, FL – City Manager Jonathan Evans has announced that Public Works/Marina Director Charles Jordan has resigned effective immediately. The position will be filled internally on an interim basis by Parks Supervisor Debora Laramee while the search for a replacement is conducted.

Subsequent to Mr. Jordan's hiring, information was made available to the city that would have eliminated Mr. Jordan from contention. The information was not included with the standard background check process utilized by the city and other public sector employers, but was later provided following a public records request.

Mr. Jordan began his employment with the city two weeks ago following an extensive search and interview process that included discussions with the City Manager, department heads, the staffs of both the Public Works and Marina Departments as well as the public.
