The decisions of Advisory Boards are presented to the Board of Commissioners as a recommendation which the Commission can choose to accept, modify or decline.

Applicants must be residents of Madeira Beach, or legal voting age and able to attend meetings on a regular basis. All applications are reviewed by the Board of Commissioners prior to being appointed to serve on an Advisory Board.
