Seafood Festival Returns to Madeira Beach in October

MADEIRA BEACH, FL – The [38th Annual John's Pass Seafood Festival](#) will draw thousands of people to Madeira Beach October 18 – 20. Hosted by the John's Pass Village Association, in partnership with the City of Madeira Beach, the annual event draws visitors from as far away as Canada and Europe.



Estimates put attendance at last year's Seafood Festival at more than 200,000. "We have people from across the country and around the world that plan their vacation around the Seafood Festival because it's so much fun," said Madeira Beach Public Information Officer Curt Preisser.

The party kicks off Friday, October 18th, 3 – 10 p.m., with live entertainment, vendors and shops offering everything from handmade jewelry to the opportunity to pet an alligator. Back by popular demand are specialty food trucks from across the region; each offering their own versions of creative seafood delights.



The fun continues on Saturday, October 19th with the Seafood Fest 5K at 9 a.m. (registration opens at 7:45 a.m.) and the party continues in John's Pass Village with gates open 10 a.m. – midnight. Don't miss the [Halloween Costume Contests](#) (kids contest at 3 p.m., adults contest at 7 p.m.)

The best party on the barrier islands continues on Sunday, Oct 20th, 10 a.m. – 6 p.m., with live music all day, your favorite food trucks creating unique seafood dishes and the best selections from vendors and shops in John's Pass Village.
