



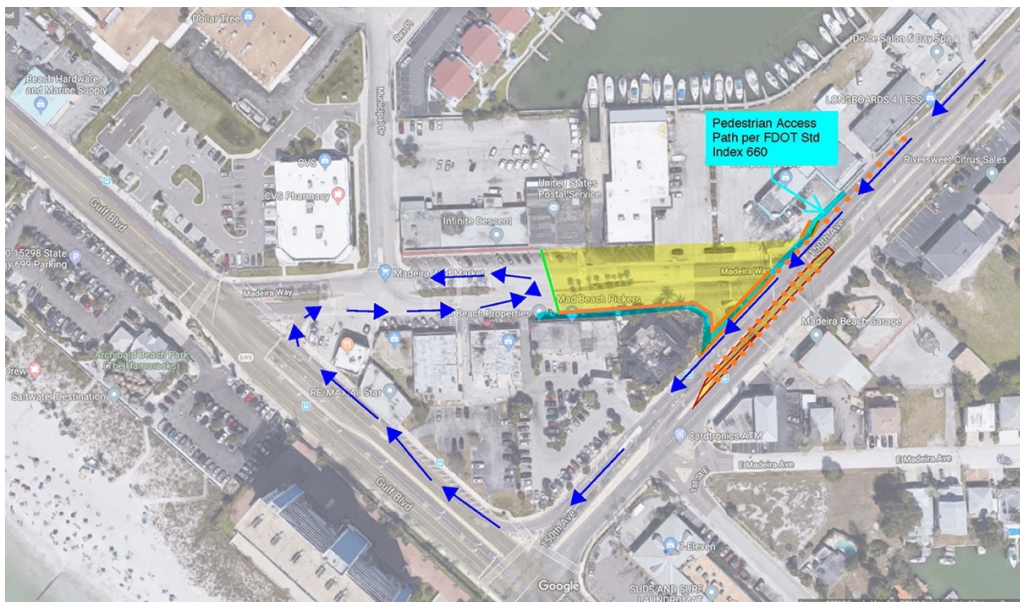

Madeira Way Renovations to Begin Monday Sept. 9th

MADEIRA BEACH, FL – The Cambria Hotel project at the intersection of Tom Stuart Causeway (150th Ave.) and Madeira Way is entering the next phase, which includes significant renovations to Madeira Way.

Beginning Monday morning access to Madeira Way from 150th Ave. from 150th Ave. to the Post Office, will result in both northbound and southbound through traffic being detoured while the street, sidewalks, medians, and streetscaping will be completely re-done. Pedestrian access will be maintained for all retail establishments and US Post Office.

Traffic will be able to enter Madeira Way southbound from Gulf Blvd. and then detoured either onto Municipal Drive or u-turned back out to Gulf Blvd. Patrons of Madeira Way shops can park in the former Brown Boxer lot or the lot behind the stores on the western side of Madeira Way. Signage has been placed along Gulf Blvd. and Tom Stuart Causeway informing motorists of the upcoming detours as well as the availability of parking in the lots behind stores.
