Pinellas County Commission Votes to Close All Public Beaches

MADEIRA BEACH, FL – Today the Pinellas County Commission voted to close all public beaches and beach parking lots in the county, including Madeira Beach, from 12 a.m. Saturday, March 21st to 12 a.m. Monday, April 6th. The action is being taken to discourage large groups of people from gathering on the beach in close proximity which increases the chances of someone transferring the Covid-19 (Coronavirus) to another person.

Any persons observed on the beach during this time will be directed to leave the sand.
